Barostim Therapy

Performed the first Barostim implant surgery in the UK on two patients at the Royal London Hospital. This is a new treatment for patients with resistant hypertension for whom no current treatment works. Currently our collaboration has won a Barts Charities grant to treat a further 30 patients.
